LEGAL NOTICE

Sealed bids will be received by the Hocking County Commissioner's Office, Hocking County Courthouse, 1 East Main Street, Logan, Ohio 43138 until 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 21, 2011, for the purchase of Corrugated Polyethylene Drainage Pipe with Bell to be used by the Hocking County Highway Department in conformity with specifications on file in the Hocking County Engineer's Office, the Hocking County Commissioner's Office and on the Hocking County Engineer's website: www.hockingcountyengineer.com.

Said bids shall be on a Unit Price Basis and shall be in writing on Proposal blanks furnished by the Hocking County Engineer.

Proposal blanks and specifications are on file and may be secured from the Office of the County Engineer, 1286 California Avenue, Logan, Ohio 43138.

Each bid must contain the full name of the company interested in the same and must be accompanied by a bond in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid amount which bond shall be to the satisfaction of the Hocking County Commissioners or a certified check on some solvent bank, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured.

Should a bid be rejected such check or bond will be returned to the bidder and should any bid be accepted, such check or bond will be returned on the proper execution and fulfillment of the contract.

The Hocking County Commissioners reserve the right to reject or accept any or all bids.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

Preparation of Bid:

- (1) Each bid should be submitted on the attached form and
- (2) Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project.

Qualifications of Bidder:

Owner may make such investigation as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and the bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein. Conditional bids will not be accepted.

Bid Security:

Each bid must be accompanied by certified check of the bidder, or a bid bond duly executed by the bidder as principal, and having as surety thereon a surety company approved by the Owner, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid. Such checks or bid bonds will be returned to all except the lowest bidder within three (3) days after the bid award, and the remaining check or bid bonds will be returned promptly after the Owner and the accepted bidder have executed the contract and the project has been completed, or, if no award has been made within thirty (30) days after the date of the opening of bids, upon demand of the bidder at any time thereafter, so long as he has not been notified of the acceptance of the bid.

Liquidated Damages for Failure to Enter into Contract:

The successful bidder, upon his failure or refusal to execute and deliver the contract and bonds required within ten (10) days after he has received notice of acceptance of his bid, shall forfeit to the Owner, as liquidated damages for such failure or refusal, the security deposited with his bid.

Completion Date:

Bidder agrees to commence work in a timely fashion after entering into a contract. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed by: see SPECIFICATIONS.

Failure to complete the project on time will result in the contractor forfeiting \$100.00 per day in liquidated damages for every day after this completion date, unless both the contractor and the County Engineer agree to a time extension and waiver of the liquidated damages due to unforeseen circumstances.

Security for Faithful Performance:

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed contract, the contractor shall furnish a surety bond or bonds as security for faithful performance of this contract and for the payment of all persons performing labor on the project under this contract, as specified in the General conditions included herein. The surety on such bonds shall be a duly authorized surety company satisfactory to the Owner.

Laws and Regulations:

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State Laws, municipal ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the contract the same as though herein written out in full.

Method of Award - Lowest Qualified Bidder:

If at the time this contract is to be awarded, the lowest base bid submitted by a responsible bidder does not exceed the amount of funds then estimated by the Owner as available to finance the contract, the contract will be awarded on the base bid only. If such bid exceeds such amount, the Owner may reject all bids or may award the contract on the base bid combined with such deductible alternates applied in numerical order which they are listed in the Form of Bid, as produces a net amount which is within the available funds.

Obligation of Bidder:

At the time of the opening of bids each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the plans and contract document (including all addenda). The failure or omission of any bidder to examine any form instrument or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect of his bid.

Material and Work Specifications:

All materials and work shall be in conformance with the latest addition of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation construction and Material Specifications.

“DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.”

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Corrugated Polyethylene Drainage Pipe with Bell shall be in accordance with the Ohio Department of Transportation Supplemental Specification 944 and AASHTO M294 Type "S".
2. All pipe shall come in standard twenty (20') foot sections.
3. This is a minimum lump order. Any additional pipe needed by the County Engineer throughout 2011 shall be provided by the contractor at the same unit price included in this bid.
4. A sufficient amount of pipe lube (grease) shall be delivered with each order of pipe at no additional cost to the County Engineer.
5. Delivery 45 days from bid acceptance.
6. Bid Security: A bid bond or certified check in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid amount must accompany bid.
7. Award of contract will be made on the basis of the total bid calculated on Unit Prices submitted.
8. Liquidated Damage: \$100.00 per day liquidated damage will be deducted from the total amount for each day late after the 45 day maximum delivery date.
9. The Hocking County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and/or all bids.
